### DENTAL HOSPITAL BUILDING

Govt. dental college and hospital Nagpur, Maharashtra was established in year 1968. Currently it is affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik and is recognized by Dental Council of India.

The institution is situated in central Indian in the campus of Govt. Medical College and Hospital Nagpur. Teaching dental hospital is 3 floor mega structure well ventilated, situated in green zone of city. This 3 floors are dedicated to 9 specialties of dental sciences along with administrative block, library, auditorium, classrooms and central store.

Institution not only runs undergraduate training, it also runs postgraduate training in 8 departments along with Ph. D. courses. Institution is well equipped with all type of latest instruments. It is first dental institution in Vidarbha region to start with both UG & PG courses.

#### GOVT. MEDICAL COLLEGE NAGPUR

Govt. dental college and hospital Nagpur is attached to Govt. medical college and hospital Nagpur. Govt. medical college and hospital Nagpur, is recognized by MCI and is affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Nashik. Institution runs MBBS, MD & MS courses in all branches of medicine including super specialty medical courses. There is separate super specialty hospital in same campus. As per DCI regulations BDS students receive regular teaching and training of the medical subjects for first three years of the BDS curriculum in the medical college. Moreover, the postgraduates of oral and maxillofacial surgery avail the facilities of emergency department of medical college. In addition 10 beds are allotted to admit oral and maxillofacial patients.
