Swadeshi Science Movement was started in Indian Institite of Science- (Bengaluru) by a few eminent scientists under the guidance of Prof. K I Vasu. This movement gradually gained momentum and emerged as an organization with national presence. In 1991(Oct 20- 21) at the Nagpur meet, it was decided, to launch the Swadeshi Science Movement at all India Level and named it as Vijnana Bharati. Vijnana Bharati has units in 22 states across the country and contacts in 4 states. It is working in 11 different areas through autonomous institutions, independent organizations & also as project entities.

Despite significant advancements in dental research, a substantial gap remains between academic findings and their application in clinical practice. Almost 90% of dental technologies and tools used in India are imported, highlighting the urgent need for indigenous innovation. This reliance not only escalates costs but also restricts the accessibility and adaptability of advanced dental care to the specific needs of the Indian population.

By encouraging student researchers, to develop practical and commercially viable products and services, this competition seeks to reduce dependency on imported dental technology, promote local innovation and entrepreneurship, and stimulate economic growth. It aims to translate academic research into real-world applications, ensuring cutting-edge discoveries benefit clinical practice and patient care directly. Additionally, it fosters a culture of innovation among dental students, equipping them with the skills and mindset necessary to drive future advancements. This competition aims to bridge that gap by fostering practical innovation in dental sciences and motivate students to think beyond CURRICULUM.

5. Time Allocation:

Each presentation should not exceed 8 minutes, including Q&A.

Clarity and effectiveness of the presentation.

Engagement with the audience.

Ability to answer questions effectively
